

Examples of information you may be asked to provide:

- Proof of ID – such as a driving licence, passport or birth certificate for all members of your household
- Proof of income – whether through wages, self-employed earnings, benefit receipts or a combination of these, we do need information on all income for every adult in a household. This can be through wage slips, profit and loss accounts or benefits award letters.
- Three months bank statements – we ask for three months bank statements for all accounts held by any adult in you are looking to be rehoused with. This is because as well as income, savings and capital can also affect priority on the housing register. If you are named on a mortgage or deeds to a house you will be asked to provide information about this too.
- Address history – you will be asked to provide a full address history for the last five years or up to ten years if you are applying for local connection properties.
- An up-to-date rent account if you rent your current property
- Any information to verify specific needs you may have. For instance if you have a medical need to move, evidence from your GP may be required.
