The marriage of Princess Diana (Kristen Stewart) and Prince Charles (Jack Farthing) has long since grown cold. Though rumours of affairs and a divorce abound, peace is ordained for the Christmas festivities at the Queen's Sandringham Estate. There's eating and drinking, shooting and hunting. Diana knows the game. But this year, things will be profoundly different. *Spencer* is an imagining of what might have happened during those few fateful days.

WHY BOOK THIS FILM? For the fun factor.

BELFAST

Kenneth Branagh, who grew up in Belfast, directs this semi-autobiographical and poignant story of love, laughter and loss in one boy's childhood, just at the onset of the Troubles. Filmed mainly in black and white, with some flashes of colour.

WHY BOOK THIS FILM? It's emotionally affecting but warm enough to be a crowd-pleaser, and Judi Dench and Ciaran Hinds are delightful as Buddy's grandparents.

"There is a terrific warmth and tenderness to Kenneth Branagh's elegiac, autobiographical movie about the Belfast of his childhood: spryly written, beautifully acted and shot in a lustrous monochrome, with set pieces, madeleines and epiphanies that feel like a more emollient version of Terence Davies. Some may feel that the film is sentimental or that it does not sufficiently conform to the template of political anger and despair considered appropriate for dramas about Northern Ireland and the Troubles. And yes, there is certainly a spoonful of sugar (or two) in the mix, with some mandatory Van Morrison on the soundtrack." The Guardian

In this musical version of the famous story, Cyrano de Bergerac (Peter Dinklage) is handicapped by his diminutive height rather than the size of his nose. He is dazzling both with ferocious wordplay at a verbal joust or with brilliant swordplay in a duel. But, convinced that his appearance renders him unworthy of the love of the luminous Roxanne (Haley Bennett), Cyrano holds back from declaring his feelings for her. Meanwhile Roxanne has fallen in love, at first sight, with Christian (Kelvin Harrison, Jr.), a young man blessed with good looks but hopelessly lacking in eloquence.

WHY BOOK THIS FILM? Peter Dinklage was everyone's favourite character in Game of Thrones.

Gradually his cooking encourages these vastly different cultures to connect and Cheng is soon a celebrated member of the community. But his tourist visa is soon to run out and it's up to the villagers to come up with a plan to help him stay.

We will always tell you if a film you have chosen is subject to a minimum charge but we cannot advise on this until bookings start to come in.

- State your venue name.
- List the dates and films you would like for May, June, July and August. **Give at least one spare film** in case your first choices are not available (We will always consult you on any substitutions that might be necessary).

IMPORTANT NOTES

Confirmations

When you book your films from Moviola, we will send you a **Confirmation Form** on which the level of charge for each film is clearly set out. You should read this carefully before replying to Toby to state that it is correct. BUT please see the clause about minimum guarantees below.

The confirmation is our agreement to supply films for you for the season and we refer back to it in any case of a query on your invoice.

It is also your licence to show the film and your proof for anyone who requests it that you have booked the film properly, so be sure to read it and keep it safe.

Minimum Guarantees

If a film on the mainstream menu gets at least 10+ bookings across the Moviola network, we can generally offer it with no minimum guarantee attached. However, if it turns out that you are the only venue showing a particular film, then you will be subject to the distributor's minimum of around £100 for film hire. If this were to be the case we would notify you of the change, and you would have the option to pick a different title.

Release Dates

While we always try to provide the most accurate release dates for titles on the Moviola Menu, these are open to change, often at very short notice. Owing to this, we may have to ask you to change a title or reschedule a date. We will always give the maximum notice we can, should a change be necessary.

During this time, please bear with us for confirmation of bookings which may take a little longer than usual, but if you have any urgent queries, get in touch with us using the contacts page at the end of this menu.

CLOSING DATES:

Bookings are open from now. Please give us at least 14 days notice of any proposed screening.

CANCELLATIONS

We cannot cancel films AFTER their screening date. It is essential to notify us of your cancellation in good time so we can inform the film distributor to prevent incurring charges ourselves.

Please do not book films for September 2022 and after from this menu. A new menu for next season will be sent to you in July.

SERVICE LEVELS

WHAT IS GOLD SERVICE?

Any venue can flip between GOLD and SILVER service for specific films by request.

Gold service is where we send a film disc to you in addition to your support disc. We then require the disc to be posted back to us using a pre-paid envelope. You are charged a nominal fee for the postage and disc service.

Gold service members benefit from pre-DVD release films that are unobtainable from retailers, but these must be sent back to Moviola via recorded delivery.

WHAT IS SILVER SERVICE?

Silver service customers purchase their own films. We will send a shorts disc to you with a trailer for your next film, unless you have indicated otherwise.

If a film is not available for purchase, then we can provide a disc under the 'Gold' service by recorded delivery for that particular screening.

Help Us Stamp Out Film Piracy

All films shown to the public have to pay a licence fee whether or not any ticket price is charged. As a Moviola venue, you operate commercial film shows in exactly the same way as your local multiplex or full-time cinema. You advertise shows and sell tickets, and the film distributors expect a proportion of your sales as film hire. If you find or hear of any venue near you which claims to be operating in a different way - for example advertising free shows or telling you that they get their films cheaper - we would like to know. It is in our interests to ensure that shows are properly licensed.
