We are open 50 weeks of the year.

Holiday clubs are run during school holidays, Monday to Friday throughout the day. Children must be over 2 years old to attend, These sessions are suitable for preschool and school aged children.

Stay and play sessions run on a Tuesday afternoon 1.30-3.30pm. Parents/carers can come and play with their young children; cost £1.50
