Other things we do.....

We have been very busy fundraising for the past few years and now have an accessible toilet at the north side of the church. We now intend to construct a small servery at the back of the church enabling us to cater for more community events.

In order to achieve this we have held many fundraising events i.e. Christmas tree festivals, concerts, the annual fete on the playing field, and quizzes.

We have a friendly Fundraising team who are the PCC plus others who are happy to help with our efforts to preserve the church and raise funds for improvements – if you feel that is something that you could help with, please contact Keith or Ann (see details at end).

We now have a group of bellringers who meet to practice on a Thursday evening and ring at special services.

We have a dedicated group of ladies who maintain the flowers in church, if you would like to join them (at present once in every 6 weeks), please contact Ann Wrench.

The churchyard is an excellent example of a Conservation churchyard and is managed accordingly, a new survey of the wildflowers (including orchids) will be carried out this summer to update the previous one.

Alburgh with Denton Primary Academy use the church during the year for their services - Easter, school leavers, Harvest festival and Christmas.

Members of the PCC go to the school on a weekly basis with “Open the Book”. We support the school in their activities.

We also donate to the Waveney Foodbank, there is a box in church for donations of food.

We also have a book swap, either swap or donate if there are any books you would like to read.

An annual Carol service is held with music by the Diss Salvation Army Band, then afterwards in Alburgh Village Hall with refreshments and more Christmas music.

We will be holding our fourth Festival of Christmas Trees in December. Last time we had 40 entries provided by local groups and individuals. The trees were made from a variety of materials and were all different and this also helps to raise funds.
