The Millennium Garden and Volunteers

The Millennium Garden is a secluded garden in the heart of the Village tended by a small group of volunteers.

We now have a compact shed, room for a wheelbarrow kindly donated and a few tools. The volunteers have developed the garden a little since starting there and are hoping soon to finish a new and unusually shaped bed to incorporate a sundial given to us last year. This will be planted up with wildflowers and other natural looking perennials and annuals. The new herb garden is flourishing, we think particularly as planted on the site of former allotments. Residents are very welcome to pick some herbs to use at home.

The Garden is situated near the village hall and there is a path that runs right through the middle. You can pass through that way to the Playing Field or Village post box, you could sit on one of the benches or look over the fence to the pond to see what is living or growing in there.

We are always looking for other volunteers to join us; we usually get together once a week on a Thursday afternoon, for a catch up and a bit of gardening, but the time and day is flexible.
